Materials

- Medium-weight worsted weight yarn (4) in your desired color
- Size H (5.00mm) crochet hook

- Yarn needle
- Scissors

Abbreviations

- ch - chain
- dc - double crochet
- sc - single crochet
- sl st - slip stitch
- st(s) - stitch(es)

Hat Pattern

All Sizes

Foundation: Ch 4 and join with a sl st to form a ring.

Round 1: Ch 1 (does not count as a st), work 12 dc into the ring. Join with a sl st to the top of the ch 1.

Round 2: Ch 1 (does not count as a st), work 2 dc in each st around. Join with a sl st to the top of the ch 1. (24 sts)

Round 3: Ch 1 (does not count as a st), *work 1 dc in the next st, work 2 dc in the next st*; repeat from * around. Join with a sl st to the top of the ch 1. (36 sts)

Round 4: Ch 1 (does not count as a st), *work 1 dc in the next 2 sts, work 2 dc in the next st*; repeat from * around. Join with a sl st to the top of the ch 1. (48 sts)

Round 5: Ch 1 (does not count as a st), work 1 dc in each st around. Join with a sl st to the top of the ch 1. (48 sts)

Round 6: Ch 1 (does not count as a st), *work 1 dc in the next 3 sts, work 2 dc in the next st*; repeat from * around. Join with a sl st to the top of the ch 1. (60 sts)

Round 7: Ch 1 (does not count as a st), *work 1 dc in the next 4 sts, work 2 dc in the next st*; repeat from * around. Join with a sl st to the top of the ch 1. (72 sts)

Round 8-13: Ch 1 (does not count as a st), work 1 dc in each st around. Join with a sl st to the top of the ch 1. (72 sts)

Round 14: Ch 1 (does not count as a st), *work 1 dc in the next 5 sts, work 2 dc in the next st*; repeat from * around. Join with a sl st to the top of the ch 1. (84 sts)

Round 15: Ch 1 (does not count as a st), work 1 dc in each st around. Join with a sl st to the top of the ch 1. (84 sts)

Round 16-19: Ch 1 (does not count as a st), *work 1 dc in the next 6 sts, work 2 dc in the next st*; repeat from * around. Join with a sl st to the top of the ch 1. (96 sts)

Continue working in this pattern (adding 12 sts per round) until your beanie reaches the desired length.

Finishing: Once you have reached the desired length, fasten off the yarn and weave in any loose ends.

Flower Pattern

Foundation: Ch 5 and join with a sl st to form a ring.

Round 1: Ch 3 (counts as a dc),work 2 dc in the ring, sl st in the next 2 chs. (6 sts)

Round 2: Ch 1 (does not count as a st),*work 1 sc in the next st, work 3 dc in the next st*; repeat from * around. Join with a sl st to the top of the ch 1. (12 sts)

Round 3: Ch 1 (does not count as a st),*work 1 sc in the next 2 sts, work 3 dc in the next st*; repeat from * around. Join with a sl st to the top of the ch 1. (18 sts)

Round 4: Ch 1 (does not count as a st),work 1 sc in each st around. Join with a sl st to the top of the ch 1. (18 sts)

Fasten off the yarn



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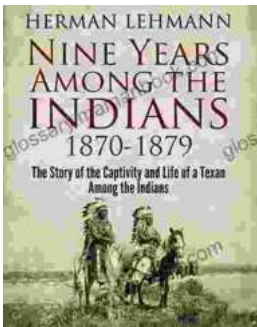
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
